

FAQ Frequently Asked Questions. We are happy to talk to you if your question is not answered.

~ **How to Apply?** A: There is an application on this website, print and follow instructions. There is a \$100.00 application fee. This fee is applied to any Enrollment for a full program.

~ **How are programs Scheduled?** A: In modules, roughly every other week, Thurs-Sat. A SCHEDULE for current times is listed on our School website, at https://docs.wixstatic.com/ugd/0bad54_8f1c7438027044f9adb4b133f3165bc4.pdf. This is the only schedule we offer. Note that Naturopath program schedules change- no Saturdays, from First Year Term #2 onward, and- Second Year- are held two Weekday Afternoons per month.

~ **How to Finance?** A: Our students have financed through their own means, and with family and job income assistance. For MASSAGE THERAPY training, students have received financial aid through MICHIGAN WORKS AGENCY- if you take this route, start the process early. We do not process student loans, but we do offer a **payment plan with a deposit**.

~ **What are policies,** for refunds, absences, grading, Leave of Absence, and so on? A: These are in the CATALOG which you may view or download, it is on this website in PDF form

~ **Does the School offer Job Placement?** A: The school receives calls every week from employers, seeking to hire. We pass this information on to our students and grads. Additionally, with our many years of experience in this field, we are able to give good counsel on the process of establishing yourself as a practitioner. NO SCHOOL can actually “place” someone in a job, so that terminology is misleading- unless the School itself hires a grad for internal hire.

~ **I have a lot of career questions** that the website supports do not answer- what to do? A: We offer a Career Consult for \$75.00, it is by appointment. Optional, but there if you need it.

~ **How can I get to know the atmosphere of the School, and Teachers, better?** A: We have welcomed prospective students for School Visit times for many years. You may rsvp to set one, or more of them up. They are one hour in duration, to sit in on a class. If desired, some of our classes and modules are open for paid Enrollment, (100\$ a day) for the day. Beyond that, some like to experience our Student Intern Clinic to receive services that the students are trained to offer. One may do all of the above!

~ **When do programs begin?** A: They begin every early September. There is a generous discount for those Enrolling fully by July 1. **General Enrollment deadline is July 15**. We encourage students to plan ahead to acquire books and equipment and to generally prepare to enter these professional programs in advance.

~ **Can I take any classes or full programs for enrichment only?** A: Yes, either as an Audit (no diploma will be given) or to fully earn a Diploma for your own enrichment.
